## How to obtain a Handicap Index.

In order to obtain a handicap index that can be administered in accordance with the rules of Handicapping, a player must be:
. A member of a golf club that is affiliated with an authorized association, or
. A direct member of an authorized association which has assumed the responsibility of a golf club, example igolf.

To obtain a handicap index a player must submit scores for 54 holes played, this can be a combination of 18 and 9 holes scores.
$3 \times 18$ hole scores, $6 \times 9$ holes scores, $1 \times 18$ holes and $4 \times 9$ hole and so on
36 holes can be marked by any member as long as that member has a handicap index, members from other clubs can also be a marker but they must have a handicap index.

All cards must have the markers name clearly on the card and date the round was played must also beon the card, both player and marker must sign the card.

The final 18 holes must be marked by a committee member or someone approved by the committee, the player keeps the cards until all 54 holes are completed then they post them in the box on the lower driving range.
